**AFTECH Unit of Fiserv Sponsors Runner for Cherry Blossom Run**

The Cherry Blossom Run gives me and the credit union industry a chance to support the Network.”

AFTECH president Joe Antellocy praised Weber's participation. “Fiserv and AFTECH both support the Cherry Blossom Run financially, but it takes on a special meaning for all of us when we know some of those actually racing,” Antellocy said.
